MEWP Operator Training “Type Specific”

The aim of the course is to provide instruction on the preparation and safe operation of a specific model of Mobile Elevating Work Platform.

At the end of the course the trainee will be able to drive the machine safely and manoeuvre it as required to correctly position and carry out required tasks in a correct and proper manner inside and outside a building.

There is a written test paper that involves 30 questions; all points will be covered during the course.
