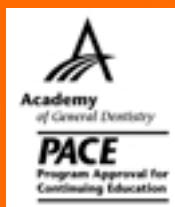

In addition, Dr. Shafie is the author of a text-book on Implant Supported Overdentures published by Wiley-Blackwell in 2007.

Dr. Tobin Bellamy received his dental degree from the University of British Columbia.
