Course Objective

The purpose of the Practitioner qualification is to confirm whether the candidate has achieved sufficient understanding of how to apply and tailor PRINCE2 to suit a particular scenario. This course has been designed for delegates who have a PRINCE2 Foundation pass based on the 2005 version of the guidance. The course will update candidates' knowledge of the 2009 guidance as well as covering the Practitioner material.

This course is designed for project managers wishing to build on their achievement in the PRINCE2 Foundation exam following further experience or a period of study.
