Course Objective

M_o_R provides structured risk management across the entire enterprise from operations to the strategic layer. The purpose of the Foundation qualification is to confirm that a candidate is able to demonstrate a knowledge and comprehension of the four elements of the M_o_R framework: Principles, Approach, Processes, Embedding and Reviewing and how they support corporate governance.

The Exam

The foundation exam, taken at the end of the course consists of:

- Question booklet contains 75 questions – 70 exam questions and 5 trial questions.
- Pass mark is a total of 35 or more out of a possible 70 (50%).
- 1 hour multiple choice, closed book.

Typically pre-course preparation will require 2-3 hours of study.
